Understandably, the experience of students during transition may be quite unique. As a consequence, many of the standard items included in end-of-course surveys may not be able to adequately capture these experiences. Provided in this document are a sampling of potential items that can be added into end-of-course surveys to gather student feedback in order to make appropriate plans for summer and fall terms.
