## Responsibilities

Job responsibilities could include the following:

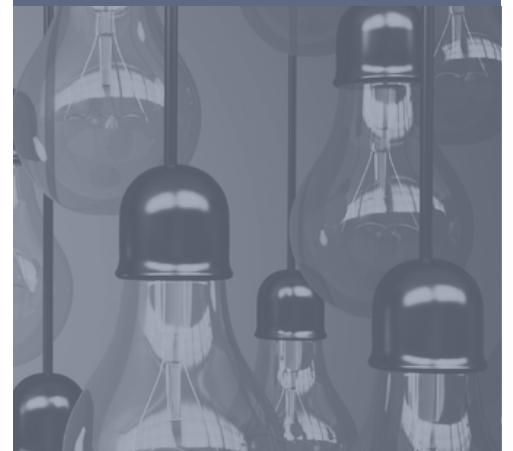
- Conduct final preparation and testing for the administration web-based surveys (e.g., Qualtrics and SurveyMonkey).
- Finalize the design of paper-based surveys.
- Facilitate qualitative data-gathering efforts.
- Develop and manage the survey administration and distribution process.
- Build and manage databases for various projects (working with "small" and "medium" data).
- Identify, manage, and share data coding and management best practices.
- Complete descriptive quantitative and qualitative analyses with minimal supervision.
- Create infographics using existing and creating new templates.
- Develop new data visualization and reporting designs/templates.
- Develop data reports based on existing templates.
- Write results reports using existing templates.
- Conduct literature searches.
- Reflect The Rucks Group's core values in all aspects of their work.
